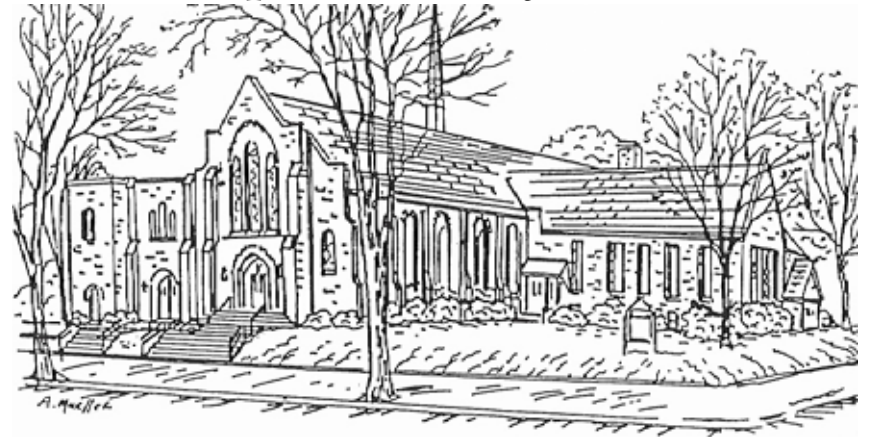

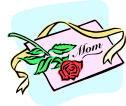
The last meeting of the season for the Killingstad/Thayer ABW members will be held on May 3rd at 11:30 AM.
